TESTING OF METER SYSTEMS

POLICY

It shall be the policy of the Cooperative to maintain accuracy of its kilowatt hour meters within acceptable commercial limits and shall institute programs of testing to maintain such meter accuracy.

RESPONSIBILITY

President/CEO and Management

PROCEDURE

1. Meter systems will be tested at intervals specified by the President/CEO and Management.
2. Consumers desiring test of the meter system can secure such test by payment of a \$75.00 test fee in advance. Such fees will be used to defray a portion of the cost of the test and will be refunded if the meter is found to be over 102% inaccurate.
3. If the test reveals that the meter is more than 2% fast, the President/CEO will decide the length and amount of adjustment based upon information available in each situation.
