JOINT MEMBERSHIPS

POLICY

It shall be the policy of the Cooperative to provide an efficient method for establishing and dissolving joint memberships.

RESPONSIBILITY

President/CEO, Management and Staff

PROCEDURE

- A joint membership may include up to two individuals to or for which the Cooperative provides or will provide a Cooperative Service, each of whom qualifies to be a Member, upon the Member making a written application on a form provided by the Cooperative.
- 2) Upon the death of one of the individuals of a joint membership, documentation, such as an obituary or death certificate, must be kept on file at the Cooperative and the Membership will automatically be converted to an individual membership.
- 3) Joint memberships can be converted to an individual membership to be held by the person continuing to receive service from the Cooperative upon either the person relinquishing the membership rights signing an affidavit on a form provided by the Cooperative, or upon the person wanting to retain the membership providing the Cooperative with a certified copy of the divorce decree and signing an affidavit that he or she continues to directly occupy or use the premises covered by the membership and that the other individual is not continuing to occupy or use the premises.
