JOINT MEMBERSHIPS

POLICY


It shall be the policy of the Cooperative to provide an efficient method for establishing and dissolving joint memberships.

RESPONSIBILITY

President/CEO and Management

PROCEDURE

- 1) An individual membership may be converted to a joint membership of more than one individual occupying the same premises to or for which the Cooperative provides or will provide a Cooperative Service, each of whom qualifies to be Member, upon the member making a written application on a form provided by the Cooperative.
- 2) Upon the death of one of the individuals of a joint membership, the surviving joint member may have that joint membership converted to an individual membership upon making written application on a form as provided by the Cooperative.
- 3) Upon one of the individuals occupying the same premises that the Cooperative will provide service until no longer occupying said premises, said joint membership can be converted to an individual membership to be held by the person continuing to receive service from the Cooperative upon either the person relinquishing the membership rights signing an affidavit on a form provided by the Cooperative, or upon the person wanting to retain the membership providing the Cooperative with a certified copy of the divorce decree and signing an affidavit that he or she continues to directly occupy or use the premises covered by the membership and that the other individual is not continuing to occupy or use the premises.
